Give Up Your Riches

“Then Jesus said unto his disciples, Verily I say unto you, that a rich man shall hardly enter into the kingdom of heaven. And again I say unto you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.” (Matthew 19:23-24)

When we think of riches, we automatically think of monetary wealth. Yet, the state of being rich is relative to the individual. I have encountered a homeless individual unwilling to give up the items they carry around in a bag from place to place. To them, it was their valued possessions, and parting with them caused them great mental pain. I have witnessed individuals who had far less than a billionaire might possess. Yet, in their eyes, their possession of beauty, talent, career, or relationship, gave them a strong sense of security and confidence. The deceitfulness of possessions (riches) becomes a stumbling block to salvation. Jesus says, “Sell all that you have.” The young rich man walked away sorrowful. He could not imagine giving up or walking away from what had become his identity, his possessions.

“Those who are rich in this world, in the vast majority of instances, are hesitant to become subjects of the kingdom in which faith is riches, and holiness is honor...The difficulties are enormous when we think of the pride of life, the flattery of rank, the danger of power, and the risk of carnal security. Yet, blessed be God, we have seen rich men become poor in spirit! We have seen camels go through this needle's eye, humps and all! We hope to see many more such miracles of almighty grace.”

Are you able to give up the thing you are holding on to that you value so much today to walk hand-in-hand in peace with God? Yes, you can pass through the needle's eye.
